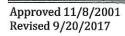

Upon the demise or relocation of the occupant in need of care, the caregiver, if still less than 55 years of age at the time, shall be required to vacate the premises within thirty (30) days.

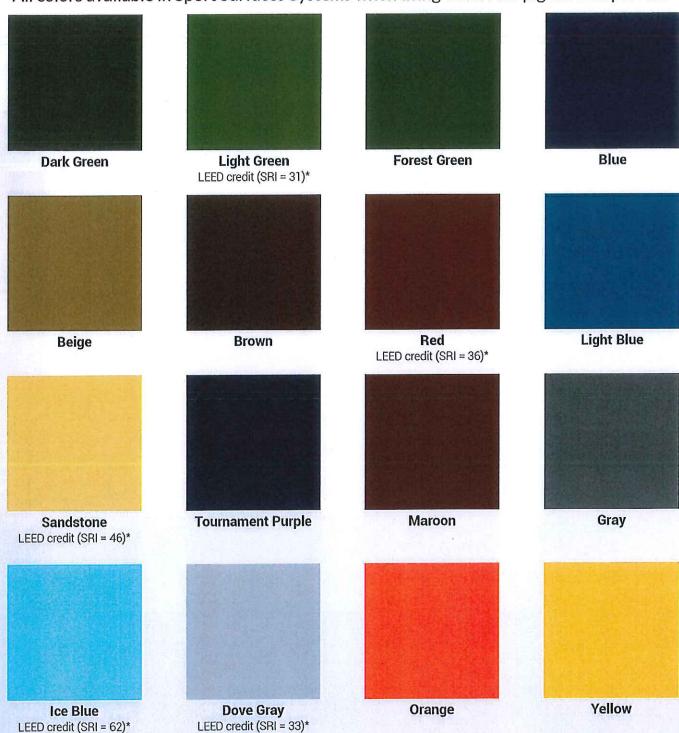

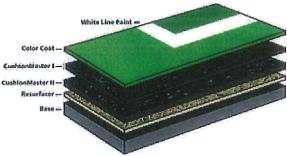

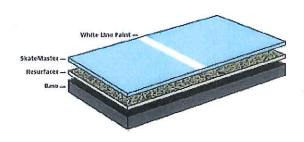
