DID YOU KNOW.....

- IT IS AGAINST FLORIDA LAW TO FEED WILDLIFE, INCLUDING ALLIGATORS.
- Snowbirds need to notify the office when leaving for the summer. Ensure the office has your correct contact info and information for the designated caretaker for your property.
- Shirts & shoes are always required in the laundry and both Ph 1 & Ph 2 buildings.
- You do not have to be a Florida Resident to be on the HPARC council, however it is a requirement to be a Trustee.
- SPEED LIMIT IN THE PARK IS 15MPH.



IMPORTANT FLORIDA LAW CHANGE

New law, in effect as of October 1, 2023, golf cart drivers under the age of 18 must be at least 15 with a learner's permit or 16 with a driver's license. Anyone who is 18 or older needs a valid government issued ID.

This change in the law is due to the number of children injured and killed while driving golf carts. Please keep your grandchildren safe and do not allow them to drive your golf cart.

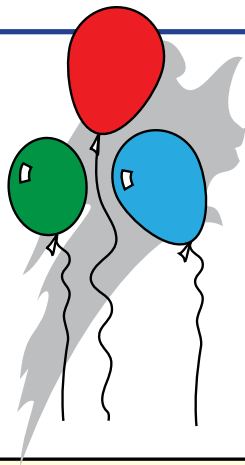
