New law, in effect as of October 1, 2023, golf cart drivers under the age of 18 must be at least 15 with a learner's permit or 16 with a driver's license. Anyone who is 18 or older needs a valid government issued ID.

Fuel Pump Skimming
Skimming occurs when devices illegally installed on ATMs,
point-of-sale (POS) terminals, or fuel pumps capture data or record
cardholders' PINs. Criminals use the data to create fake debit or credit
cards and then steal from victims' accounts.

#### **Tips When Using a Fuel Pump**

- Choose a fuel pump that is **closer to the store** and in direct view of the attendant. These pumps are less likely to be targets for skimmers.
- Run your debit card as a credit card. If that's not an option, cover the keypad when you enter your PIN.
- Consider paying inside with the attendant, not outside at the pump.

If you think you've been a victim of skimming, contact your financial institution immediately.
