A few things I would like to mention, please register all your guest at the office; See general rules and regulations:

We are sending violation notices to homeowners regarding the absence of a carport. Please adhere to the rules and regulations. If I contact you or send a letter, please reply, or contact me to discuss. This is on our website: ACC Rule # 13

#13 No coach may be placed upon any lot unless there is also affixed thereto a carport, a minimum of sixteen (16) feet in length by eleven (11) feet wide in the clear. a. No coach, or structure, may be placed or erected on any lot closer than six (6) feet from the property line on the sides, ten (10) feet from the property line at the rear and ten (10) feet from the property line abutting the road. All measurements shall be from the base of the unit. b. The front setback shall conform to the setback line established by adjoining units. c. All siding used for coaches or other structures must be approved by the ACC. d. Supports required for carports, or other structures, such as porches & sheds, should be constructed with aluminum, steel, or other approved material. Wood must be encased in either aluminum, vinyl siding, PVC sleeve, or painted to match the coach or painted white.

DID YOU KNOW.....

- HPARC Membership cards will only be available in the PH 2 card room on Mondays 8 – 10 thru January 29th.
- Guests must be registered in the office prior to using the hall or other park facilities.
- Top covering and footwear must be worn at all times in both recreation halls and the laundry.
- If you plan to use the exercise room stop at the office to sign a new waiver and have your code reset.
- If you use the compounds and haven't already done so, stop at the office to swap out your key.
- Speed limit in Holiday Park is 15 mph.

Hello Everyone, I would like to address the Architectural Control Handbook, section 1-Gutters & Downspouts. Guttering and Downspouts, must be installed on coaches and added structures. Discharge openings should be at least eight (8) inches from the ground.



The majority of the new homes the guttering & downspout discharge openings are being brought to ground level. If this applies to you as the homeowner, please put some sort of barrier, to protect your guttering and downspouts. Holiday Park and US Lawns will not be responsible for damages.

Reminder, if you choose to maintain your own lawn and property, please advise the lawn crew.

Golf cart parking is also available in the designated spaces of the parking lots in front of and on the side of the club house. The change in parking for the picnics is to give the workers room to get from the charcoal cooker to the serving tables and to the beverage area. Please do not park in spaces obviously designated for cars. The entry ways will be the same as always—on both sides of the big tree. PLEASE DO NOT ENTER area marked with caution tape. Please abide by the NO PARKING lines. Sometimes golf carts, scooters, bikes, and cars are parked on these painted lines which mean NO PARKING in this space. This is important so that there is always access for emergency vehicles if they are needed. It's important to remember that all residential lots of Holiday Park are private property and require permission from the owners if you want to walk across or park on their property.

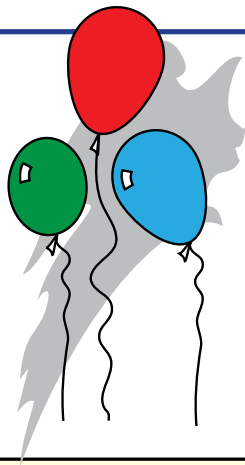
