DID YOU KNOW......

- Membership in ARC is limited to homeowners, spouse/significant others living in the same household. 1st year of membership after purchase is free.
- We have a Memorial Pathway near gazebo on Tuscola. Bricks may be purchased for \$50.
- Remove all loose items during hurricane warnings or when leaving for more than 30 days.
- IT IS AGAINST FLORIDA LAW TO FEED WILDLIFE, INCLUDING ALLIGATORS..
- SPEED LIMIT IN THE PARK IS 15MPH.

IMPORTANT FLORIDA LAW CHANGE

New law, in effect as of October 1, 2023, golf cart drivers under the age of 18 must be at least 15 with a learner's permit or 16 with a driver's license. Anyone who is 18 or older needs a valid government issued ID.

This change in the law is due to the number of children injured and killed while driving golf carts. Please keep your grandchildren safe and do not allow them to drive your golf cart.







Fuel Pump Skimming

Skimming occurs when devices illegally installed on ATMs, point-of-sale (POS) terminals, or fuel pumps capture data or record cardholders' PINs. Criminals use the data to create fake debit or credit cards and then steal from victims' accounts.

Tips When Using a Fuel Pump

- Choose a fuel pump that is **closer to the store** and in direct view of the attendant. These pumps are less likely to be targets for skimmers.
- Run your debit card as a credit card. If that's not an option, cover the keypad when you enter your PIN.
- Consider paying inside with the attendant, not outside at the pump.

If you think you've been a victim of skimming, contact your financial institution immediately.
